I'm hoping we get through February without any Subzero temperatures. Remember the course is Closed as long as there's frost on the ground or the temperatures are below freezing.

90 Degrees

Does anyone really know what driving your cart 90 degrees really means? I've been surprised as I observe cart drivers here at the club every day. A high percentage of you cart drivers either don't know what 90 degrees means, or they don't care what 90 degrees means. Oh, and the " I forgot" excuse doesn't work anymore.

The 90-degree rule is how your supposed to drive your cart while playing golf at Athens C.C. Let's drive our cart on Hole #1-Let's Say you hit your drive down the treeline. Since there is cart path available it is recommended you keep your cart on the path until you are equal distance with your ball. Then you turn right (90 degrees) and head for your ball. Once you've hit your second shot you can proceed to your ball keeping your cart in the rough or go back to the cart path driving equal distance with you ball the turn 90 degrees to your ball. If your close to the green or on the green remember to park your cart either on the cart part or 50 feet from the green. The no cart signs between the green and #8 tee box mean just what it says, No Carts. The objective is to keep the carts out of the fairways as much as possible. It is a course rule that all carts "must stay on the cart paths" on all par 3's. If you can observe the 90-degree rule our fairways will be in great shape to grow back in this Spring!!!

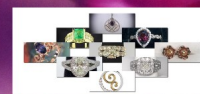

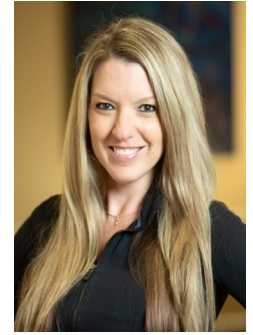
Notes from the Staff

From the Fitness Center Director

If you are pressed for time but don't want to miss your workout, then come to the ACC Fitness Center and complete a simple and quick circuit routine.

First, warm-up on the treadmill or another cardio machine for five to ten minutes. Next, do 2-3 rounds of each strength training machine going counter clockwise, starting with the leg press machine for 15 reps. If you are not burning at the end of the set, increase the weight. Then, cool down for 5-10 minutes on treadmill or until heart rate is back to resting rate. Finally, finish with a full body stretch.

This whole process should take about 30 minutes. We can all do that! If you need extra help or new ideas, let me know!
