We have also applied a granular fertilizer to the course, we will continue to slowly fertilize the course throughout the growing season with our fertigation unit (liquid fertilizer injected into the irrigation system).

We will soon begin our annual spraying battle with the weeds on the course. This is a yearly ongoing competition; the fight is a struggle at times with the elements. But we will continue our quest for dominance the remainder of the season!




