We have completed our spring pre-emergent weed control to the course. Also, as the season progresses, we will continue to apply post emergent herbicides to eradicate the weeds as they germinate. We will begin vertical mowing and topdressing the greens later in the month. We are scheduled to aerate the greens Monday, May 8th and follow with tee boxes and fairways.
