

They say that April showers bring May flowers, well April has finally stepped it up with some needed moisture. The current weather has been a rollercoaster ride, warm then cool. The lingering cooler temperatures, especially nighttime temps are not favorable for good Bermuda grass growth. The days are getting longer and soon warmer, which means the grass will eventually take off.

We will be aerating the greens on Monday, May 8th. 1948 Then we will follow the greens aerification by aerating the fairways and tee boxes. After all the golf course has been aerified, we will apply our first fertilizer application to the entire course.

Please remember to follow the 90-degree rule on all fairways. Also, cart paths only around all tees and greens. I know concrete is not cheap, but I promise you will not wear it out by staying on it as much as possible, the grass will thank you later.
