Last thing we all need to do is sand your divots even though there's no grow back this time of year it will set things up for the Spring.


Help take care of your course. We have something to be proud of here at Athens Country Club. We don't realize how lucky we are until you go play somewhere else and see the difference.

Happy New Year! It is hard to believe the holidays and another year have passed. Whatever happened in the past year, The New Year brings fresh beginnings.

This time of year can be like a roller coaster for the weather in Texas. Warm, then cold, and sometimes wet with all the above. Fortunately, so far this year's weather has not been too bad for golf and the turf grass. We are trying to stay ahead of the game by adding moisture if needed and feeding the greens with fertilizer anytime we have signs of green up. We have also acquired covers for greens for added protection when the temperatures stay below freezing for a minimum of 24 hours. Putting on and removing the covers is a large task, it is not something that can be done in a matter of minutes. When covers are used, they will be placed out the day before predicted low temps and removed the day after.

We are also working on winter preventative maintenance of our equipment fleet, so that it is in tip top shape for the upcoming growing season. We will also begin dormant spraying the golf course for winter weeds. Please remember to use the cart paths as much as possible during the dormant season, damage can occur rapidly, and recovery will be longer in the spring.


Pickleball and Tennis lessons starting at 6:00 Monday thru Thursday.

We have a lot of great projects and events planned for everyone this coming year, and as always, thanks for supporting your club. Let's all raise a glass to a beautiful 2024.




## **From the Fitness Center Director**




## EVENT RESERVATIONS
