The crew has done a great job with maintaining the course at a high level. The course was in great shape for the Men's Invitational this past month and was a success. 1015 We have added a new nursery green next to the white tee box on number 10 and it is coming in nicely. This green was added by saving the aerated cores from the last greens aerification. The crew has also added a few new trees around the course.

We will be aerating the greens for the last time later this month. Noah has also diligently sprayed annual weeds around the greens and course. The turf will likely turn yellow during the spray applications but will return to color within a few days. With this heat let's try and remember 90 degrees in fairways, I promise we won't wear out the concrete and the grass will be grateful. Stay safe and keep hydrated and remember to fill divots and repair ball marks!

From the Tennis Courts


We really enjoyed Kids Kamp on July 23-26. It was a lot of fun! We had 20 happy campers that played a lot of pickle ball and tennis.
