Every so often, I must remind our membership of a few club policies we must adhere to. First, "outside" alcoholic beverages are not allowed on club property. This not only goes against club policy but also violates Texas state law. This includes the swimming pool and golf course. All alcoholic beverages must be purchased through Athens Country Club. 1021 If you are found to be in possession of any alcoholic beverages not purchased at the Athens Country Club, the club does have the right to remove those beverages, and member and or guest could be subject to a fine (not to exceed \$500), asked to leave the property immediately with no refund of any sort given, and possible suspension from Athens Country Club. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.

Also, for the safety of our members and their guests, parking is strictly prohibited in the area adjacent to the front doors, marked with a red curb and the "No Parking" sign. Members violating parking regulations will be subject to a fine of \$100 per instance, which will be billed to their account. We have recently added two additional handicapped parking spots for our members and guests who have a valid and visible handicapped parking permit.

Lastly, we're thrilled to announce our upcoming Kids Camp, scheduled for July 23-26th. Last year's camp was a huge hit, and we're aiming for an even bigger and better event this year. 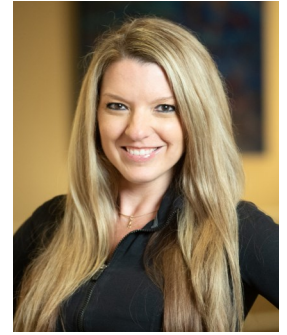

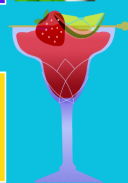
