The Greens committee has decided that we will not perform our third and final greens aerification so not to disrupt the greens before the men's Pea Picker tournament. We will pick it back up in the Spring. Also, we will begin fall pre-emergent with fertilizer applications to prevent winter weeds this month. Please remember to do your part in repairing divots and ball marks as well as using the cart paths as much as possible.

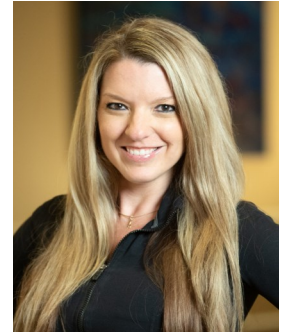
